Advanced Open Water Diver

What is Advanced Open Water Diver?

The Advanced Open Water Diver Course, more commonly just referred to as the Advanced Course, offers divers experiential learning above and beyond their first few certification dives.

The Advanced Course allows entry-level divers to become more comfortable and gain experience in different diving scenarios, such as deep water, underwater navigation, night diving, boat diving, and more.



How do I become an Advanced Open Water Diver?

The Advanced Open Water Diver Course is experiential in nature. There are no quizzes or test, just knowledge reviews and dives. The course consists of five (5) dives; two (2) core and three (3) elective. The required core dives are a **deep dive** and a **navigation dive**. This will give you experience in deeper water and help you to build underwater navigation skills. Then you must complete three (3) elective dives which can be any of the specialty dives offered by Surface Interval Training, such as **Night Dive, Drift Dive, Digital Underwater Photography, Wreck Dive, Boat Dive**, and many more.
